HIGHLIGHTS & SUCCESSES

Expanding Our Library: Thanks to the Washington County Riverboat Foundation generous grant, we were able to begin our library expansion project. We moved to a temporary location in downtown Wellman at the beginning of May and construction began shortly after. This project is doubling our library space, adding a much needed programming room and study room, creating an accessible space, and allowing us to grow our collection and services for our community. We anticipate completion to occur in early 2024.

Summer Reading Program: We created and launched expanded Summer Reading Programming for the summer of 2023. In addition to providing a large variety of presenters and activities for our children's program, we launched a brand new Teen Summer Reading Program; providing programming content specifically for community teens and reading challenges. We also created a more engaging Adult Summer Reading log and saw an vast increase in participation with 70% of registered participants completing the log, whereas only 20% completed the previous year.

Increase in Programming and Events: We more than doubled our program offerings in FY23. Our mission is "Inspiring imagination, sparking curiosity, and creating community." We are working to fulfill this mission by expanding our programs to engage our community. We planned programs for children, teens, and adults throughout the year in order to better serve our whole community.
